What is Camp Exec?

Camp Exec is a premier leadership camp for teen girls. If accepted, you'll join a class of like-minded young women from across San Diego to learn, listen, and share your dreams with some of San Diego's most accomplished women professionals. Throughout the weekend, these top-level women will hold unique, collaborative sessions, then gather with you around the campfire to talk about how they got where they are now. Plus, they'll hear your hopes for the future and help you map your pathway there.

On Friday, you'll meet your squad: a small group of female professionals and fellow mentees who share your strengths and are invested in your growth. Together, you'll grow leadership and career skills in a camp setting. In addition to squad time, you'll practice social and business etiquette, projecting a positive image, developing a personal brand, and networking, as taught by the pros. Highlights include dressing up for a formal dinner, as well as introducing your mentors to our high ropes course and all your favorite camp activities!

Dates: Thursday-Sunday, Sept. 20-23

Who: Girls in grades 10-12 (2018-19 school year)

Cost: \$50/registered girl member, \$65/non-Girl-Scout; financial aid available

Do not submit payment with the application. If you're selected, you'll pay to accept and reserve your spot.

Where: Camp Whispering Oaks in Julian, CA

About 90 minutes from San Diego, Whispering Oaks offers the comfort of modern cabins in the beautiful outdoors. Each living unit includes three cabins with bunk beds and a nearby program shelter with modern bathrooms. Paved, lighted pathways connecting living and activity areas wind through native trees.

By Monday, July 23, submit your completed application online. All applicants will be scheduled for a group interview the week of Aug. 6-10 or 13-17, and will be notified of their status by Friday, Aug. 24.
