As the #BestPlace4Girls, we provide opportunities for girls to thrive and become strong leaders as they participate in activities developed by experts in these four program areas: STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math), the outdoors, life skills, and entrepreneurship.

Within an all-girl, girl-led environment and supported by dedicated and trained volunteers, Girl Scouts took the lead—in their lives and in the world—with a record-setting 2018! Highlights included:

- Girls building their confidence through 21,057 STEM experiences.
- 13,088 girls exploring the outdoors on Girl Scout camping weekends.
- Sending the 3 millionth package of Operation Thin Mint<sup>SM</sup> cookies to military overseas.
- Simplifying and enhancing the member experience for 11,313 volunteers by offering in-person outdoor skills training, online general trainings, and increasing community collaborations.

## *to Build Confidence*

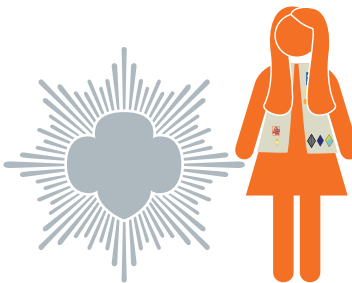

The Girl Scout Gold Award, Girl Scouting's highest achievement, is a top-tier credential for girls, enabling them to distinguish themselves in the college admissions process, earn college scholarships, and enlist in the military one rank higher.

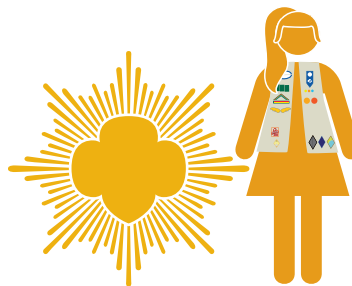
Earned by just five percent of Girl Scouts annually, the Gold Award requires girls to demonstrate their leadership abilities by creating sustainable projects that address a local issue with a global link. Earning the award is often a multi-year process that involves more than 80 hours of community service, education, and advocacy.
