

Girl Scouts San Diego uses certification programs developed by American Safety and Health Institute (ASHI) in compliance with

G2015 global guidelines that meet Girl Scouts of the USA standards. Videos deliver consistent content, with a written test and hands-on practice confirming learners have achieved skills needed to help others in need.

We offer Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED, which is childcentered but includes adult and infant certification. Classes are available for adults and girls 6th grade and up (girls under age 14 will receive a certificate of completion). There are three options for this training:

Standard Class: An instructor will guide you through videos, hands-on skills practice, and a written, open-book test. Earn a 2-year certification. Best for beginners. Cost is \$45; duration 5 hours.

Blended Class: Watch videos at home or on your mobile device in advance. Then, attend an instructor-led, hands-on skills session. Complete the written, open-book test and skills demonstration to earn your 2-year certification. Cost is \$45; online class 2-3 hours plus 2.5 hour in-person class.*

Our classes meet Girl Scout requirements for first aiders who are within 30 minutes of emergency medical services (EMS). Wilderness First Aid or Wilderness First Responder certification is needed for outings more than 30 minutes from EMS.

* Note for those who need First Aid/CPR/AED for work or other agency compliance: Due to the abbreviated class time, this option may not fulfil time-based requirements. Check with the agency requiring the training.
