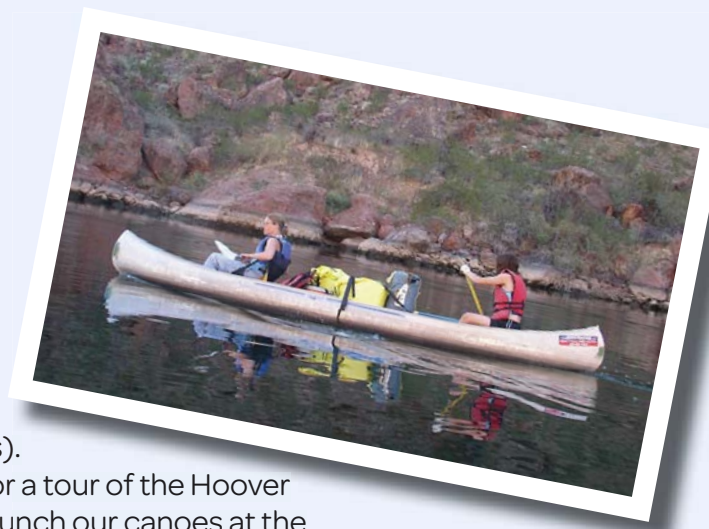


Canoe Odyssey

Paddling, camping and hiking adventure trip
Sunday, April 1- Sunday, April 8

Join us for an exciting canoe adventure in San Diego and on the Colorado River! We'll start off in San Diego learning canoe skills, teamwork, trip-planning and safety at Mission Bay (Sunday-Tuesday; lodging at our Balboa Campus cabins).

Then we're off to the river! We will drive up on Wednesday for a tour of the Hoover Dam. Our Odyssey continues Thursday morning when we launch our canoes at the breathtaking base of the dam. Tents will be our "home" during this portion of the trip. Paddling through the dramatic and mysterious Black Canyon, we'll stop along the way to hike spectacular slot canyons and soak in natural "hot tubs" of spring water.
