

# COUNCIL LEVEL AWARDS

## Membership Numeral Guards

are presented to registered adults to present the total number of years spent in Girl Scouting as an adult *and* girl. This pin is presented in increments of 5 years. After 15 years, this pin is presented at the council level.

## Volunteer Years of Service Pin

is presented to registered adults who have given volunteer service to Girl Scouting. This pin is presented in increments of 5 years. After 15 years, this pin is presented at the council level.



## Appreciation Pin

is presented for service rendered where the candidate has delivered outstanding service to at least one service unit area or program delivery audience.



## Honor Pin

is presented for service rendered where the candidate has delivered outstanding service to at least two service unit areas or program delivery audiences.



## Thanks Badge

recognizes an adult member whose performance is truly outstanding and benefits the entire council.



## Thanks Badge II

recognizes an adult member who has already received the Thanks Badge.



## President's Award

recognizes the efforts of a Service Unit area in moving its communities toward achievement of the council's goals during the membership year.

## Cookie Award

is presented to service unit cookie coordinators and area managers who have gone above and beyond their duties to promote the cookie sale including increasing sales and for providing extraordinary service to volunteers.

## Courage, Confidence and Character Award

is presented to an individual who has made a significant impact on the organization's success through volunteer service and leadership in a community project, as well as demonstrated quality of leadership through service to service units, multiple troops or girl activities.

## Friendship Award

recognizes superior service, contributions or assistance to Girl Scouts, San Diego-Imperial Council, by an individual, group/organization or business.

## Family Award

is presented for service rendered over a period of time by more than one family member that enhances Girl Scouting and benefits girls beyond the troop level.

# SERVICE UNIT LEVEL AWARDS

## Outstanding Volunteer Award

recognizes an adult in a position other than or in addition to leader whose service benefits a Service Unit area or program audience in a way that is beyond the expectations for the position.



## Outstanding Leader Award

recognizes troop leaders and assistant troop leaders whose performance in working with girls is so outstanding that it merits recognition by the service unit.



## Spirit Award

recognizes non-member individuals, groups/organizations or businesses that have offered service of non-monetary support to Girl Scouts that is deserving of recognition.

## Award of Distinction

recognizes any registered adult Girl Scout volunteer who has completed appropriate training and carried out the duties and responsibilities for the position that they hold for the entire year.



## Leadership Development Pins & Leaves

recognizes volunteers for meeting basic adult leadership training requirements. Additional leaves may be earned by pursuing continued training.
