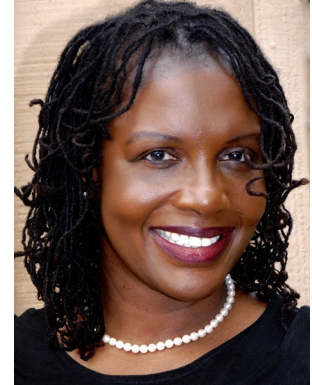


Regina Hillman Buckley
