Brownie Quest

1. The Purpose of Brownie Quest

The trail of life can be confusing. Throughout *Brownie Quest* you will explore who you are. You will also learn more about sisterhood by remembering ELF – Explore, Link Arms, and Fly. With the help of your community, you can go for your biggest dreams on the trail of life!

2. Take Action Project

To complete *Brownie Quest*, finish the Journey and complete a take action project. Work with friends or by yourself. Adults are there to help you too.

NOTE to adults—This is a project your girl should plan and lead. It doesn't have to be big. It's important she discover her world. What does she see? What does she want to change? How can she take steps to help make those changes?

Now, let's explore your community.

Examples:

- Plan a hike. Follow it by leading a discussion about what you did.
- Visit a local library and find a book about sisterhood.
- Come up with a theme song for your community.

3. Discover Key, Connect Key, Take Action Key, and Brownie Quest Award

- Throughout *Brownie Quest* you have the option to earn the Discover Key, Connect Key, Take Action Key, and Brownie Quest award.
 - Discover Key: Discover who you are and your values.
 - Connect Key: Connect with your community, family and Girl Scout sisters. Explore how your actions affect others.
 - Take Action Key: How can you make the world a better place? Make a plan, and take steps to create that change.
 - Brownie Quest: First, earn the Discover, Connect, and Take Action Keys. Then, learn how all three Keys work together to unlock lasting change and grow leadership skills.

4. Field Trips

Now it's time to discover and connect with the world around you.

NOTE to adults—Field trips can help widen her world and broaden her sense of community.

Examples:

- Ride bikes around the city.
- Pick out a place that you connect with and share it with a friend.
- Visit a farmers market.
