Daisy Outdoor Journey

1. The Purpose of the Outdoor Journey

Let's go outside and check in with the *Outdoor* world. Whether you are exploring your backyard or going to a national park, through this Journey you will gain skills and maybe even a lifelong passion for the environment. What will your outdoor adventure become? It's up to you!

2. Take Action Project

To complete the *Daisy Outdoor* Journey, use Volunteer Tool-Kit (VTK) and finish a take action project. Earn the Buddy Camper, and Outdoor Art Maker badges. Work with friends or by yourself. Adults are there to help you too.

NOTE to adults—This is a project your girl should plan and lead. It doesn't have to be big. It's important she explore her world. What does she see? What does she want to change? How can she take steps to help make those changes?

Now, let's make the world a better place. What did you see when you were outside? What do you want to take action on?

Examples:

- Pick up trash in a local park.
- Help a neighbor cleanup their garden.
- Think about what you might need when you are outside. Then share what you learned.

3. Daisy Buddy Camper and Daisy Outdoor Art Maker Badges

- To complete this Journey you need to earn the Daisy Buddy Camper and Daisy Outdoor Art Maker badges.
 - Daisy Buddy Camper: You can earn this in three steps. Help plan a camping trip. Help pack for the camping trip. And go camping!
 - Daisy Outdoor Art Maker: You can earn this in three steps. See the colors of nature. Hear the sounds of nature. And share your outdoor art.

4. Field Trip Ideas

The world is filled with exciting places to visit and explore!

NOTE to adults—Field trips help expand her community. Help her develop a lifelong relationship with the world outside.

Examples:

- Go on a hike.
- Take a bike ride.
- Walk along a creek.
- Find a pond near you and visit it.
