Welcome to the Daisy Flower Garden

1. The Purpose of Welcome to the Daisy Flower Garden

Learn about the world around you. See how insect, plants and all life interacts. Once you've done the exploring and observing, then you will create a plan for a take action project.

2. Take Action Project

To complete *Welcome to the Daisy Flower Garden*, finish the Journey and complete a take action project. Work with friends or by yourself. Adults are there to help you too.

NOTE to adults—This is a project your girl should plan and lead. It doesn't have to be big. It's important she explore her world. What does she see? What does she want to change? How can she take steps to help make those changes?

Now, let's take action. What did you learn about how plants, and insects interact? What do you want to take action on?

Examples:

- Plan and lead a planting or growing project.
- Help clean up a local park.
- Plant some flowers in a public area.
- Learn about honey bees.

3. Watering Can, Golden Honey Bee, and Amazing Daisy Awards

- Throughout the Journey you have the option to earn the Watering Can, Golden Honey Bee, and Amazing Daisy awards.
 - Watering Can: This award is earned by caring for you own mini-garden. Then explore what the Promise and Law means to you.
 - Golden Honey Bee: Make the world a better place, when you plant and grow something.
 - Amazing Daisy: Do you know the Girl Scout Promise? Can you explain what the Promise and the Law mean to you? Now make a promise to live by the Girl Scout Law.

4. Field Trip Ideas

i It's time to explore the world around you.

NOTE to adults—Field trips help plant a seed of growth in girls by showing them how other people solve community problems.

Examples:

- Check out a community garden.
- Go to a local park.
- Visit flower fields.
