## Signs that help girls shine!

Wearing a message of their own lets girls shine as Girl Scout Cookie™ entrepreneurs and helps them attract more customers.

Encourage girls to bring creativity to their drive-thru or pop-up cookie booths by decorating their signs with bright ribbons and crayons.

## Supplies:

- Two poster boards
- Two pieces of ribbon (2 feet long each)
- Markers or colored pencils
- Hole punch
- Clip art or pictures

## Steps

- 1 Design a colorful front and back for your walking poster using markers, colored pencils, pictures and clip art.
- 2 Write your price per box, your cookie goal, the words "Girl Scout Cookies" or any other big ideas you want to advertise.
- 3 Punch holes at the top of each poster, about 1 inch from the top and 3 to 4 inches from the side, and adjust to fit.
- 4 Tie one end of one piece of ribbon to the front poster and the other end to the back poster. Repeat for the other side and be sure to allow enough room to place it over your head.
- 5 Show off your cool new design!
