Eat a food representative of a country where a World Centre is located.

Celebrate a holiday or custom from another country with food, clothing, crafts, games or songs.

Learn one of the following songs: *Our Cabaña Song*, *Sangam Song*, *It's a Small World*, or *The World Song*, or *Our Chalet Song* from.

On a world map, locate 15 countries that belong to the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts.

Do a service project that Juliette Low's troop might have done.

Do a skit about Juliette Low.

Learn a Girl Scout or Girl Guide Promise from another country.

Have an international game day and/or costume party.
