Important Deadlines:

- **Bronze Award** final reports must be submitted no later than **Sept. 30** before advancing to Cadette level in Girl Scouts.
- **Silver Award** final reports must be submitted no later than **Sept. 30** before advancing to Senior Level Girl Scouts. The deadline to attend the Silver Award Ceremony is **April 1**.
- **Gold Award** final reports must be submitted no later than **Sept. 1** of a Girl Scout's high school graduation year. The deadline to attend the Gold Award Ceremony is **April 1**.
