### WOW! Wonders of Water

#### 1. The Purpose of WOW! Wonders of Water

- i** Explore water and how it is used throughout the world. Dive deeper into how water can be used wisely, and then share what you learned.

#### 2. Take Action Project

- i** To complete *WOW! Wonders of Water*, finish the Journey and complete a take action project. Work with friends or by yourself. Adults are there to help you too.

**NOTE to adults**—This is a project your girl should plan and lead. It doesn't have to be big. It's important she explore her world. What does she see? What does she want to change? How can she take steps to help make those changes?

Now, let's explore the *Wonders of Water*.

**Examples:**

- Visit a nursery school and read a water-related book to the class.
- Write and put on a mini-water-skit, teaching others to use resources wisely.
- Make three healthy snacks that are water-based and share your recipes.

### 3. LOVE Water, SAVE Water, SHARE Water, and WOW Awards

**i** Throughout the Journey you have the option to earn the LOVE Water, SAVE Water, SHARE Water, and the WOW awards. The directions for each are found on pages 107-109.

- **LOVE Water:** List things you know and love about water. Now, make a personal promise for how you are going to protect water.
- **SAVE Water:** Find a way to save water in your community.
- **SHARE Water:** Pass on what you learned. Tell others how they can save water too. You can even create a water pledge for people to sign.
- **WOW:** Once you have completed the SHARE Water award you can earn WOW. Show how you made a difference with your SHARE Water project. Talk about what you did and how it relates to the Girl Scout Law.

### 4. Field Trips

**i** Let's check out some of the *Wonders of Water*.

**NOTE to adults**— Field trips give girls the opportunity to explore and discover the world in an interactive way. Help broaden her world while she learns how other people solve community problems.

**Examples:**

- Visit a water park.
- Go to an aquaponics farm.
- Look at the way water is used at your school.

**i** You did it. You completed *WOW! Wonders of Water*. You finished a take action project and hopefully the optional awards too.
